

PRACTICE MEDICINE IN WOODLAND HILLS

Kaiser Permanente's Woodland Hills Medical Center opened in 1986 on a 28-acre site in the high-tech Warner Center in the West San Fernando Valley.



Our medical center houses 212 beds for inpatient service for major specialties, and for some tertiary specialties, including neurosurgery, tertiary MCU, and plastic surgery.

The Woodland Hills Medical Center supports several satellite medical offices with one each in Woodland Hills and Simi Valley, and two in Thousand Oaks, Oxnard, and Ventura as well as a behavioral health office in nearby Reseda.

Together, the hospital and medical offices—with more than 400 physicians and a support staff of nearly 2,700—provide services for nearly 194,000 Kaiser Permanente members. Patients visit our offices from communities throughout the San Fernando Valley, as well as Westlake, Malibu, Calabasas, Thousand Oaks, Agoura, Simi Valley, Oxnard, Camarillo, and Ventura.

Known for its Centers of Excellence, including a Craniofacial Clinic and Breast

Center, Woodland Hills Medical Center offers physicians an opportunity to become part of an innovative team that practices quality medicine, and is committed to expanding existing services and introducing new ways of delivering care using advanced diagnostic and therapeutic modalities. Medical education and physician participation in practice design are integral parts of the Woodland Hills philosophy. Also, many of our physicians have teaching appointments at the nearby University of California, Los Angeles and the University of Southern California.

In addition, our Family Medicine Residency Program provides training to 18 residents. The residency is highly regarded for its educational programs and is affiliated with the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA.
